Subject: Board Determinations (December 12, 1995) and USSS OPEN Documents

At the meeting this morning, the Board voted to open the following documents in full:

180-10097-10495	014122
180-10087-10362	006912
180-10117-10086	015052

The first two are already open at Archives II. Jane Vezeris stated in her letter of December 11, 1995, that after discussing the third document (180-10117-10086) with the CIA, the USSS no longer has any objection to full release.

In her December 11, 1995 letter, Jane Vezeris indicated that the Secret Service would like to delay until January the Board's decision on the protective documents so that she could verify the status of these documents. In order to accommodate the wishes of the Secret Service, we did not present these documents to the Board at the December meeting. I have enclosed two sheets from Box 15 of the LBJ Library material. One clearly indicates that the three reports in question are included in the list of "Unclassified Documents-NSF-Warren Report Recommendations." The other document indicates that several materials from Box 15 were released in the 1976-1977 period.

Steve Tilley assured me that all the material in Box 15 has been open at Archives II since 1993.

The members of the Board have the December 11,1995 letter from the Secret Service, and they will be able to consider Jane Vezeris' remarks about the November releases. Her comments suggest that the Secret Service will not appeal the Board's determinations from November.
