De Freese wrote the Final Survey Report for Miami trip. Miami Secret Service agent *Ernest Aragon* wrote report on Miami Cuban affairs; *Talmadge Bailey*, local Miami agent; *Robert Jamison*, local Miami agent. DEFREESE SAID THERE WAS A THREAT TO THE PRESIDENT (MILTEER) BEFORE THE MIAMI TRIP. DeFreese went to Houston on November 21, 1995 to assist Houston advance agent, *Ron Pontius*.
- b. **David Grant**: Secret Service White House detail advance agent for Chicago visit November 2, 1963. Grant prepared the trip with JFK military and air force aides. Pre-advance work took place in two-week period before the Secret Service's normal one week advance activities.. Chicago office special agents: *Abraham Bolden, Conrad Cross, Edward Tucker*; and Chicago Acting Special Agent in Charge, *Maurice Martineau*. Grant was advance agent for Chicago trips of March, 1963, November, 1963; assistant advance agent Dallas trip of November 22, 1963
- 3. Other agents: ATSAIC Stout and SA McIntyre, SAIC Jordan (Philadelphia)
