- 1. From Parkland Hospital to Love Field: S.A. Hickey and member of Dallas Police Dept. (Hickey had ridden in the Presidential follow-up car and had been in charge of the AR-15 rifle.)
- 2. From Love Field to Andrews Air Force Base: S.A.s Kinney and Hickey aboard AF C-130 (arrived 8 PM November 22, 1963)
- 3. From Andrews Air Force Base to White House garage: S.A. Kinney and S.A. Charles Taylor (arrived at 9PM)
- 4. White House garage: car was parked and a plastic cloth placed over it at 10:10 PM. Two guards watched the car.

November 23, 1963

- 5. Midnight to 8AM shift takes over in White House garage: S.A.s Paroschos, Kennedy, and White House Policeman J.W. Edwards
- 6. At 1 AM Nov. 23, 1963, Dep. Chaief Paterni arranged for FBI team to examine limosine: Orrin H. Bartlett, Charles L. Killiam, Cortlandt Cunningham
