--Gerald Behn interview by HSCA:

on communications:

The Secret Service White House Detail was in touch with the motorcade through the Dallas switchboard of the Signal Corps; motorcade agents could communicate directly with White House detail headquarters

--Eileen Dineen report to Robert Blakey about trip to Secret Service Training Center: Team IV Review -9-29-78: the Secret Service responded to question about **ammunition**. Because of this I should be able to request information from Center Pointe about ammunition, and perhaps, weapons

- --Thomas Kelley deposition: said specific foreign (non Cuban) threat to President in late 1950s and early 1960s existed.
- --Thomas Lelley deposition: mentioned inspection of November 21, 1963 drinking by Secret Service agents
- --Thomas Kelley deposition: FBI and SS exchanging information may have compromised an informant
- --Gerald Behn deposition: communications on November 2, 1963
