Subject: US Secret Service Protective surveys

In our August 19, 1996 letter to the Secret Service, we requested evidence for any postponements in eight protective surveys designated assassination records at the August 5, 1996 meeting. Today we received two protective surveys with postponements [154-10002-10422 and 154-10002-10423]. Jane Vezeris's letter of October 15, 1996, explains her reasons for claiming a 6(3) postponement for each of three names.

All of the names are in open documents as follows:

Wayne Gainey: open in 180-10118-10032, and in USSS-HSCA correspondence (Blakey to Goff, April 5, 1978) [180-10125-10002]

Rohinsky: open in USSS-HSCA correspondence (Blakey to Goff, April 5, 1978) [180-10125-10002]

Derber: open in USSS-HSCA correspondence (Blakey to Goff, April 5, 1978) [180-10125- 10002]

The staff recommendation is to open these documents in full:

154-10002-10422 154-10002-10423

Because these RIF numbers are not yet in the USSS database and therefore not in review track, Board members will not find them in the voting machine. Instead, Board members can record a vote to release these documents in full by initializing the enclosed sheet.
