Subject: US Secret Service Postponements That Can Now Be Released

In November 1995, the Secret Service presented several documents with requested postponements of addresses of Secret Service agents and employees. The following documents contained these postponements, several of which were sustained by the Board beginning in January 1996:

On August 9, 1996, the Secret Service presented more addresses of agents it wished to postpone. In our letter of September 26, 1996, we pointed out that all of these addresses are open in 180-10125-10002 [USSS correspondence with HSCA]. Because of the existence of lists of agent addresses in the HSCA correspondence, the following postponements apply:

180-10080-10276 should have no postponements

180-10106-10100 should have no postponements

180-10086-10342: only Robert Bouck's and Elmer Moore's addresses should be postponed.

180-10085-10498 should have no postponements

180-10075-10118 should have no postponements

180-10070-10276 should have no postponements
