I have received your letter of December 4, 1996, regarding two documents [154-10002-10422 and 154-10002-10423]. These numbers refer to two US Secret Service protective surveys for President Kennedy's trips in 1963. Your letter acknowledges receipt of my letter to Director Bowron of December 2, 1996, and my letter to you of December 3, 1996.

I am writing to clarify the *Federal Register* announcement for the November 13-14, 1996 meeting of the Assassination Records Review Board. The Review Board voted not to sustain any postponements in the two protective surveys [154-10002-10422 and 154-10002-10423]. The Review Board's vote will be noticed in the *Federal Register*, a copy of which I have enclosed with this letter. You have seven days from the date of publication to appeal the Review Board's determination.
