Today, I received a call from Janice (the receptionist). She stated that a "Richard Jameson" was calling. I told her to take a message since I was otherwise occupied. In speaking with Janice, she stated that this "Jameson" had initially called and asked to speak with the attorney working on the Robert White/Evelyn Lincoln matter. When I wasn't available, he told Janice he did not want to leave a message. He also told Janice that Robert White would be selling his collection of Evelyn Lincoln items at the Gurnsey auction in March. Jameson also stated that the tapes referred to in Seymour Hersch's book came from Evelyn Lincoln and were given to Hersch by Robert White. He said that no one had listened to them yet publicly. He also stated that Janice should tell me that I was in a coma and that I needed to wake up. Jameson refused to leave a telephone number. Call came in at approximately 11:00 a.m. on January 9, 1998.
