Subject: Marina Oswald Porter electronic surveillance

In response to our request for a search of FBI electronic surveillance records for any place where one of the "Core" subjects was a conversant in a conversation subject to FBI electronic surveillance, the FBI produced only one additional record which met this request. In the record Marina Oswald Porter, widow of Lee Harvey Oswald, was overheard in 1978 discussing how to send a package to her sister in the Soviet Union. The Review Board staff reviewed this record and determined it did not need to be processed as an assassination record.
