January 30, 1995 HSCA correspondence with other Federal Agencies

Generally these are letters requesting information from the following; the Department of Health, Education and Welfare, the Department of Labor, the Federal Aviation Administration, the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, the Social Security Administration, the Veteran's Administration, the U.S. Civil Service Commission, and the U.S. Coast Guard..

- A letter from Blakey dated August 30, 1978 to the National Transportation Safety Board requesting all information and files related to the plane crash that killed Congressmen Hale Boggs.
- An outside contact report dated May 30, 1978 with the Social Security Administration which describes what kind of information the SSA can give the HSCA. They cannot give the current address if supplied with a name and ss# because they get the information from IRS.
- In an outside contact report dated 3/29 (I'm assuming of 1978) Jacqueline Hess writes of a contact with Nik Edes of the Department of Labor's Office of Legislative Liaison. She told them to expect a letter of request for intelligence files. There is no such letter here and no response from the Department of Labor.

• On January 13, 1978 Blakey wrote to the FAA to request access to files concerning hearings held about David Ferrie.
