The Queens County District Attorney's Office initiated an investigation of Mr. Lane after hearing a complaint from a woman who described him as her boyfriend and her employer. The woman had an outstanding debt at Alexander's Department Store in Queens, N.Y. in the amount of \$100. When Mr. Lane did not pay the debt for her, the woman presented the appealed photograph and information to the District Attorney's office. Although the District Attorney presented the information to a grand jury, the grand jury did not issue an indictment of Mr. Lane. In reporting these events to Headquarters, even the New York office of the Bureau recognizes its weakness. The New York office writes, "The above is place in the administrative section of this report since it contains a great deal of conjecture and opinion on teh part of Patton (the D.A.) and Anderson (the Credit Manager of Alexander's Department Store)."
