2. FBI Records

The FBI's file on Lee Harvey Oswald contains seven documents which reference Yuri Nosenko. These documents all date from the spring of 1964, soon after Nosenko's defection, and relate information Nosenko provided regarding the KGB's dealings with Oswald while he was in the Soviet Union. The seven documents were opened in full by the FBI in the initial processing of the Bureau's Oswald file. The Bureau also produced approximately 325 pages from the FBI's file on Yuri Nosenko to the House Select Committee on Assassinations. The Bureau documents the U.S. government's effort to determine whether Nosenko was a bona fide defector in these records. The FBI claimed minor postponements in these documents, and the Review Board voted to sustain the claimed postponement. The Review Board did not request any additional Nosenko records from the FBI.
