HSCA correspondence with Local and State Governments

- In an August 30, 1978 letter to the City of Dallas Health Department, Blakey asks for any information on seven individuals: Edward Benavides, Lee Bowers, Jr., Thomas Hale Howard, Jim Koethe, Nancy Jane Mooney, Earlene Roberts, and James R. Worrell.
- In an August 30, 1978 letter to the Louisiana Department of Health, Blakey asks for any information on Albert Guy Bogard.
- July 7, 1978, a letter to Dallas Police Department requesting access to documents from the polygraph examination give to Buell Wesley Frazier on 11/29/63.
- A May 17, 1978 letter to New York City Police Commissioner Robert J. McGuire in which Blakey lists 97 individuals (mostly organized crime figures) and asks for access to any files on these individuals. He also asks if they have any electronic surveillance on these individuals.
- A May 4, 1978 letter to Executive Director of the Chicago Crime Commission, Stephan Schiller in which Blakey lists 110 names (mostly organized crime figures) and asks for access to any files on these individuals. A letter of the same date to Ronald -Ewert of the Illinois Legislative Investigating Commission is identical.
