Dear Board Members:

Jack has asked that we discuss on the conference call today the issue of whether the Review Board should depose the doctors who treated President Kennedy at Parkland Hospital in Dallas immediately after the assassination. In preparation for our discussion, I am enclosing the following:

- (1) The statement that Eileen mailed to the public last Friday stating that the Review Board would be making available for purchase copies of information that the staff has collected relevant to the medical evidence.
