Re: Follow-Up to Request for FBI's file on CIA-James Angleton

Dear Carol:

I am writing to confirm our telephone conversation yesterday in which I requested that the FBI document its destruction (in 1967) of documents from the file captioned, "CIA -- James Angleton." In addition to any documents recording the destruction of serials in or enclosures to the Angleton file, please provide the Review Board with a written explanation of the FBI's search for the Angleton records and the results of that search.

Along the same lines, the Review Board remains interested in liaison between the FBI and the CIA during the years surrounding the assassination. To that end, the Review Board requests that the FBI provide us with a list of FBI files that bear the caption, "CIA -- _____ (name) _____." To the extent that such a list is extremely lengthy and burdensome to produce, please feel free to discuss with me a narrowing of the scope of our request.

Thank you, as always, for your continued cooperation with the work of the Review Board.
