Subject: Summary of New Orleans Administrative File
(Follow Up to FBI-17)

I have completed my review of six sections of the FBI HQ New Orleans administrative file, FBI number 66-68, that the FBI produced in response to our request for additional information. The vast majority of documents in the file relate to office space, bureau cars, and equipment/inventory of the New Orleans Field Office and its resident agencies. I found two documents, described below, that may be relevant. If you approve, I would like to show Carol Keeley these two records and ask her if the FBI will agree that they are assassination records and process them as such.
