Subject: CIA-IR-14 Breckinridge Files

The Review Board requested the CIA to determine the disposition of the files of Scott D. Breckinridge, the CIA focal point for the House Select Committee on Assassinations. In response to the Review Board Informal Request for Additional Records and Information CIA-IR-16, the CIA provided a file held by the Office of Congressional Affairs and a small number of computer references from the Office of the Inspector General. Almost every document in the Office of Congressional Affairs file was found to be a duplicate of materials already located in the CIA sequestered collection.

These materials consist of internal CIA memorandums, press clippings, and internal responses to articles on the Kennedy assassination. This file was designated an assassination record as a unique file and will be processed for inclusion in the JFK Collection at the National Archives. The computer references from the Office of the Inspector General consist of an index of letters and queries to the Inspector General on the Kennedy assassination. Original or full text copies of this material are not saved or archived. No additional assassination records were designated from the computer references from the Office of the Inspector General.
