I have completed my review of Dallas field office files, FBI numbers 62-3069, volume 1; 92-99I, volume 1, serial 1; 105-1484, volume 1; and 157-203, volume 3, serials 315-317 that the FBI produced in response to our request for additional information. None of these files seemed to relate to the assassination; however, I would like to note, given the prominence with which these gentlemen appear in FBI HQ files and the amount of influence they were known to exert upon national and local politics, it seems awfully strange that the Dallas field office would only have two files and two other references to any of these five men.

I have completed my review of FBI HQ C-References on Clint Murchison Jr. and Sr. These included documents 29-28704-2224, section 85; 62-9-46-364, section 7; 92-6170-225, section 5; 94-38133-5, no section number; 46-37140-18, section 1; 65-67648-149, section 5; 62-97810-31, section 1; 46-55359-198, section 9; 58-5520-248, section 5; 58-5520-1394, section 32; 58-5520-1467, section 34; 62-9-9-867, section 16; 63-8946-185, section 3; 63-9953-98, section 1; 63-9953-66, section 1; 63-9953-41, section 1; 63-9953-8, section 1; 109-12-211-11910, section 216; 109-12-267-188, section 5; 105-145165-265, section 8; 97-4592-89, section 6; 97-4592-61, section 5; and 137-9890-2, no section number. None of these references related to the assassination or seemed to implicate involvement in a conspiracy to assassinate the President. Most of the documents were memos from Dallas to Director, FBI regarding business dealings that the Murchisons were involved with, many of them a little shady or tainted by connection to the mob. Murchison was also involved in some international business deals with the president of the Dominican Republic and the Haitian government. There are also a couple of letters and replies between Clint Murchison, Sr. and the Director in the way of invitations to speak. The Director refused each time. There also appears to be an investigation into Murchison's connection to hosting Senate "sex parties".

I completed my review of FBI HQ C-Reference documents on H.L. Hunt and his sons Lamar Hunt and Nelson Bunker Hunt. This review produced very little in terms of assassination records. The majority of documents related to various business dealings, some maybe a little dirty, some maybe not. Quite a number of documents were filed in regards to H.L. Hunt's conservative radio programs and support for conservative groups or individuals. And while it appears from the documents that H.L. Hunt did not like Kennedy or his administration a whole lot, he was a financier of other political campaigns. I have completed my review of FBI HQ C-Reference search files that the FBI produced in response to our request for additional information, FBI-38. Of these files none of them related to the assassination. Most documents dealt with information Rothermel provided to the FBI regarding financial dealings of H.L. Hunt as well as a few tidbits on Hunt's radio program LifeLine. I recommend that none of the following be designated assassination records.

Hunt, FBI file number 62-108867, section 1, serials 1 through 24, that the FBI produced in response to our request for additional information. This file was a correspondence file between H.L. Hunt and the Director. It appears Hunt felt the need to update Hoover periodically on his activities, especially in regards to his radio program, LifeLine. I did identify four assassination records for designation.
