Our staff has undertaken a preliminary review of records in the CIA sequestered collection related to the activities of certain Cuban exile groups during the time frame surrounding the assassination of President Kennedy. Our review indicates that the following records are not currently included in the collection.

In requesting access to these materials, we are not designating them "assassination records" and we are not, at this time, requesting that copies be given to the Review Board.
