Re: ARRB Request for Additional Information and Records No CIA-8

Dear John:

Pursuant to the authority under the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992, the Assassination Records Review Board requests that the Central Intelligence Agency provide access to any and all internal histories or retrospective studies or reports on the following topics:

1. The JMWAVE Station;
2. The Mexico City Station;

In addition, we would like to request:

3. All organizational information on Agency bases and/or the existence of a formal Agency presence in the New Orleans, LA area during the time frame of March 1960 to September 1964;
4. Information on crypts with the ZR digraph;
5. The classified version of the segregated collection index.
6. Personnel files for individuals who used the throwaway aliases of "Ron Cross," "Bert Henry" and the pseudonym "Doug Gupton."

This request should be interpreted in the broadest reasonable sense. To the extent that you question whether a particular type of study or report is encompassed by our request, please let us know and we can advise you whether we seek to include it.

Should any of these requests impose an unreasonable burden on you that we may not have anticipated, please advise us so that we can work with you to modify or amend the requests accordingly.

In requesting access to these materials, we are not designating them “assassination records” and we are not, at this time, requesting that copies be given to the Review Board.
