Much of the holdings in the HPSCI files were copies of Rockefeller Commission correspondence, many of them detailing information requests between the Rockefeller Commission and the CIA on a number of different issues. Included among the files were papers investigating the CIA's relationship with Lee Harvey Oswald, correspondence between David Belin and Mark Lane regarding Lane's upcoming movie, and examinations of the allegations against E. Howard Hunt and Frank Sturgis (the hobo issue).

Other notable papers dealt with allegations against the CIA brought by comedian and noted dietician Dick Gregory (transcripts of interviews with the Rockefeller staff); the independent evaluations of the JFK autopsy and ballistic evidence (among others, the Lattimer and Wecht reports); correspondence between Paul Hoch and E. Henry Knoche (CIA) re: specific information requests to the DCI's office.

Of particular interest were: a memorandum to CIA personnel on how to deal with criticism of the Warren Commission report, and an interview with John Stein of the CI staff on the domestic activities of the Agency (breaking/entering).

There were very few redactions in the documents I reviewed.

The preponderance of Rockefeller Files and lack of actual HPSCI papers may indicate that these files were put in the wrong box.
