SUBJECT: CIA-Originated Records From the National Security Agency (NSA)

Attached are fourteen Central Intelligence Agency-originated records that were found in NSA Archives as a result of searches conducted in accordance with Public Law 102-526 (The JFK Records Collection Act). These documents, according to their cover memoranda, were referred to CIA in 1993. NSA informs us that they have not yet received a response from CIA.

The Office of Policy, NSA delivered these documents to the Assassination Records Review Board along with other Third-Agency originated documents found in NSA files. Because of a lack of a response from CIA, the ARRB has agreed to handle the official referral of these files.

As you can see, the documents consist of thirteen Foreign Broadcast Information Service (FBIS) reports (officially marked "unclassified") and one draft statement from the Director of Central Intelligence (with no classification markings). We would appreciate it if your office could review the material and make an appropriate recommendation to the Review Board. Once a decision has been made regarding the disposition of these documents, you can be assured that we will notify both your office and the Office of Policy, NSA.

We look forward to your response.
