SUBJECT: Transmittal of 83 NSA Documents to the JFK Assassination Collection, National

- 1. This memorandum hereby transfers 83 original National Security Agency documents to the Access Staff, National Archives and Records Administration, College Park, MD. These documents were formally voted on at the 13-14 March 1997 meeting of the Assassination Records Review Board.
- 2. The attached memorandum from James P. Cavanaugh, Deputy Director of Policy, NSA, to the Assassination Records Review Board dated 09 April 1997 (at A), specifically, item (1), states that NSA was delivering 86 documents to the Assassination Records Review Board based on the ARRB's determinations from the 13-14 March 1997 meeting. These 86 documents do not include document 144-10001-10153, which was pulled from this batch for future consideration by the ARRB at the request of NSA.
- 3. Of these 86 documents, three (3) have been pulled for further processing, thus leaving a total of 83 that have been decided on as a result of the ARRB meeting of 13-14 March 1997.
- 4. Redacted copies of these documents were forwarded by Eileen Sullivan, ARRB, to your office per your request of 14 August 1997. As a result, no additional redacted copies will be included in this delivery.
