Dear John and Barry:

It is our understanding that earlier this year the Central Intelligence Agency transferred to the National Archives original records it held that had been created by the staff of the House Select Committee on Assassinations. It has recently come to our attention that CIA has not, however, transferred all of these congressional records to the Archives. We understand that CIA's reason for not having transferred the remainder of the congressional records is due to the particular sensitivity of the documents. (In our review of some of the HSCA staff notes at the Archives, we found several pink sheets reading "Sensitive Original Withheld by CIA.")

The ARRB would like to examine these original records and would appreciate the Historical Review Group's assistance in identifying and collecting the records and making them available to ARRB staff members at the earliest possible date, preferably next week. I have enclosed a list of those records which ARRB staff members have already identified.
