To complete the work that ARRB undertook in its joint records review trip to the John F. Kennedy Library in June, it is important that members of ARRB staff once again visit the Kennedy library. While there, they will need to review the following records:

- The remaining Cuba records (9 boxes) in the National Security Files [have CIA, State and DOD yet finished their uncompleted boxes?]
- The remaining Presidential Office Files (9 boxes)
- Presidential Recordings
- The remaining private collections:
  - Amory (Boxes 1, 3, 16, 20, 26, 27, 30-32)
  - Byrne [ARRB will have to resubmit request for access]
  - Chase, Gordon (Chron files only)
  - Chayes (Boxes 5 & 8, Cuba and Vietnam [although these appear to be 1970s])
  - Cleveland (Boxes 17, 22, 26, 34, 37) [need to obtain access?]
  - Dillon (Boxes 2-5, 14-22, 34-35, 41-44)
  - Dungan (Box 3, chron files)
  - Gordon, L. (Boxes 1-4)

- Kaysen (Boxes 16, 27) [from early 1970s?]
- Manchester (Boxes 4-7, 13, 17-18, 20-21, 44, 50, 62, 64, 69, plus tapes) [ARRB needs to request his permission; JFK Library has sent his address]
- Navasky (Boxes 17-18, 26a-33, 35-36)
- Oberdorfer (Microfilm of diary re Cuban prisoner exchange)
- O'Brien (Boxes 20, 23, 24, 30-31, 35, 40-41, 48, 55, 69, 71)
- O'Donnell (Boxes 2-3, 6)
- Powers (Box 1, MS 85-05)
- Roberts (Boxes 9-10, 12, 15) [ARRB needs to request access]
- Salinger (Boxes 125-26, 130, 136-40, 143)

We very much appreciate the fine cooperation that you and your staff extended to us in June and look forward to another successful visit in the near future.
