Subject: Additional Questions for Gestetner Interview

After reading the Goodpasture deposition, I propose the following additional questions for the Gestetner interview.

- Was it your and/or your wife's responsibility to follow-up on the headquarters cables that were sent to the Mexico City Station in response to the station's October 8, 1963 cable about Oswald's visit? [p.83 - AG claims that the responsibility for follow-up would have been the Soviet desk officer.]
- Did you see any problem with including the description of the unidentified man in the 10/08/63 cable, even though the station had not determined whether or not this photograph was of Oswald? Was this your decision to include the description? [pgs. 96-99 - AG claims that this description should not have been included. She believes that they should have waited until HQ sent a photograph of Oswald to the station.]
- Did the Oswald visit to the Soviet Embassy take on more significance when you learned from headquarters that Kostikov was a KGB officer and a member of the 13th Department? [p.124-25 - AG claims that Gestetner should know the answer to this question.]
- Did you request and/or receive a "copy" of the Oswald tape from Anne Goodpasture? [pgs. 146-148 - AG remembers that she brought in the Oswald tape from Arehart and gave it to Gestetner and Dillinger.] If so, where did you file this section of tape after Feinglass compared the voices?
