  requests for information regarding specific individuals or entities,
  certain internal CIA memoranda, and other various materials relating
  to the investigation of the JFK assassination
- Letter regarding classification of certain requests from the Committee

   specifically mentions two letters from the HSCA dated December

   20 and 22, 1977, in which the HSCA has made nine and eleven requests, respectively (letters not in our possession)
- Mention of HSCA request and receipt of a CIA Document Disposition
   Index; request for 57-volume collection of files a/k/a Oswald File
- CIA made available all files regarding Loran Eugene Hall CIA states that there is no relationship between Hall and the CIA (only response to a HSCA request documented in this collection of correspondence)
- Use of CIA Document and Item numbers in some requests by HSCA may be useful to us at a later date
