In preparation for your meeting with CIA on Friday, I have compiled the following list of records relating to Oswald's trip to Mexico City that the ARRB would like to request from CIA.

 Tapes of Oswald intercepts recorded during his visits to the Cuban and Soviet Embassies in Mexico City.
