Thank you very much for your expedient reply to my letter of June 28, 1996. I appreciate your detailed responses and I hope to continue this open dialogue.

In response to the two inquiries from your letter, I can offer the following information:

- We have some documents relating to this event that originated with the Warren Commission and FBI. Most of these documents contain sensitive information, which still require declassification by certain federal agencies. Nonetheless, I have enclosed one document that represents the official Warren Commission explanation.
- 2) Enclosed is the document that you requested, which is cited in the "Final Report of the Select Committee to Study Governmental Operations With Respect to Intelligence Activities." Furthermore, to answer your question concerning FOIA, you can request any records from CIA or any other federal agency regardless of your citizenship.
