This FBI record may be particularly difficult to work through. It in fact comprises a number of reports prepared by the FBI's San Antonio field office on various dates concerning right-wing or Cuban emigre groups. These reports were collected and sent to Headquarters in response to a Warren Commission request in 1964.

The San Antonio field office sent multiple copies of some of these reports to Headquarters. Some of the "original copies" of these reports in the Headquarters file have the names of sources permanently blacked out -- I surmise as part of an effort to put the information in the reports in a form suitable for dissemination to the Warren Commission. However, there are also unredacted "original copies" of such reports.

As to the postponements themselves, the Board already has voted in other records to release the names of each of the informants named in this record. Accordingly, the staff recommendation is to release their names and file numbers in this record also. The only redactions that the staff recommends should be sustained are for the informant-specific parts of the symbol number and file number for another informant, which appear on the tabbed pages.
