

POINTS FOR DEA MEETING, 7/19/95

Search for records

Have all components of DEA headquarters (e.g., Administrator's office, general counsel's office) been searched? Who performed the search? Were there written directives as to what constituted a responsive "assassination record?" Have all field offices been searched?

How was the search (including negative results) documented?

What was the scope of the search? Did the search include documents at Federal Records Centers? At offsite DEA storage facilities? Did the search include records of agencies that were merged into DEA upon its creation (e.g., the Bureau of Narcotics)?

Specific items from the 135's?

Liaison files with Warren Commission, HSCA, Rockefeller Committee, Church Committee, Pike Committee?

Liaison with the Secret Service?

Request all documentation of search under our Act.

Could we have copies of records destruction/retention policies and procedures for DEA/Bureau of Narcotics records, as in effect from 1960 to present?

Where would Bureau of Narcotics records be stored today?

Records from Bureau of Narcotics field offices?

Records from overseas offices?

Can you think of anyone else who might be knowledgeable about the nature/location/disposition of Bureau of Narcotics records from the 1960's?
