The ARRB staff requests access to records from FBI Headquarters and the Baltimore, Dallas, Denver, New Orleans, and Washington, D.C. field offices related to the following individuals:

(a) Adele Elvira Uskali Edisen;<sup>1</sup>

(b) Jose Rivera (reportedly a physician who worked at the National Institutes of Health in 1963); and

(c) Winston de Monsabert (or "Monsavert") (reportedly affiliated with the Biochemistry Department of Loyola University in New Orleans in 1963).

In public testimony before the Review Board and on other occasions, Dr. Edisen has stated that, in New Orleans on November 24, 1963, she recounted to an FBI agent and a Secret Service agent her knowledge of apparent dealings that Dr. Rivera and Mr. de Monsabert had with Lee Harvey Oswald in 1963.

If you find that records responsive to this request have already been processed under the JFK Act, please identify those records for us.
