The Review Board, at its March 18-19, 1996 meeting, voted to open in full three assassination records from the HSCA files that the National Archives and Records Administration had referred to the Secret Service. At its April 16-17 meeting, the Review Board voted to suspend the opening of these records for 60 days, in order to allow the Secret Service further time to provide evidence in support of certain postponements that the Secret Service wishes to retain under Section 6(3) of the JFK Act.
