Subject: Post-Assassination Interview of Marina Oswald by INS

As Dennis and I have discussed, James Hosty's book describes an interview with Marina Oswald by an unnamed INS representative from Washington, D.C., taking place before FBI agents were permitted to interrogate her after the assassination. Per Dennis's "agency contact" database entry, our contact at the INS has advised that he can find no report of this interview.

The attached FBI records (all now open in full) from the Headquarters file on Marina Oswald describe an INS representative named Fred K. Harvey, Jr., flying from Washington to Dallas on November 28, 1963, to speak to Marina Oswald. Although these records differ in certain respects from the account in Hosty's book, I believe they describe the same event.

We may wish to give copies of the attached to the INS, with a more formal request to look for records pertaining to Harvey's interview.
