Subject: Referral of Assassination Records from Ford Presidential Library

Enclosed are eight records (thirteen, including duplicates) which the Ford Presidential Library has identified as responsive to the JFK Act and which may contain FBI equities. We request that the FBI review these records for release to the public under the JFK Act, and advise the Review Board of the results of this review.

In addition to the above records, we understand that the Ford Presidential Library previously referred 44 assassination records (including duplicates) to the FBI under the JFK Act. The enclosed lists set out the Record Identification Numbers for these records.

I have reviewed the copies of these 44 records that the Ford Presidential Library has provided to the ARRB staff. I believe that there is relatively high public interest in disclosing the information contained in these records and that, under the disclosure standards applied by the JFK Task Force, these records could be released with minimal redactions. Accordingly, the ARRB staff requests that the FBI expedite its review of these referred records and advise the ARRB of the results of this review.
