

## SUGGESTED CATEGORIES -- ROUTINE POSTPONEMENTS IN FBI RECORDS

### Section 6(3) -- Privacy

Social security numbers.

### Section 6(4) -- Informants

Informant-specific part of informant symbol number.

Informant-specific part of informant file number.

Informant name, where negative contact and informant confirmed as still living by sufficiently specific identifying information (*e.g.*, name + SSN; name + date of birth; name + exact address).

### Section 6(1)(B) -- Intelligence Source or Method

Entire symbol number for electronic surveillance in foreign counterintelligence context.

## SUGGESTED CATEGORIES -- ROUTINE RELEASES IN FBI RECORDS

### Section 6(4) -- Informants

Name and any accompanying identifying information for informants who are dead or whose present status is unestablished. [This includes symbol numbers and informant file numbers in documents containing other information that unambiguously identifies the informant.]

### Section 6(1)(B), 6(1)(C) -- Intelligence Source or Method/Foreign Relations

Postponements that reveal only an investigative interest in “hostile” foreign establishments or personnel, without revealing any “source or method.” [This category includes technical “postponements” with a release date of August 1996.]
