Dear Mr. Wolfe:

We have been informed by a former staff member of the Church Committee that the Committee maintained an extensive collection of index cards, organized alphabetically by subject, to record and file all materials relating to the Church Committee's work. The former staff member estimated that these index cards comprised 50 drawers.

To assure that all relevant materials of the Church Committee have been identified under the JFK Act, the Review Board requests that any such index card system be made available for its inspection. In addition, you have identified a master log for the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence ("SSCI") that you have used to locate transcripts of the Church Committee. We also wish to inspect that log.

Finally, we would like to arrange a meeting with you so that we can review the present status of JFK Act work being undertaken by the SSCI. I will call you to set up a convenient time to meet.
