Subject: Church Committee Records --  
June 19, 1975 Testimony of James Angleton

The testimony of James Angleton on June 19, 1975 pertains to several different topics, including Lee Harvey Oswald, Soviet defector Yuri Nosenko, and other matters connected with the Kennedy assassination.

In addition, this testimony also covered discrete issues wholly unrelated to the assassination, and the CIA has marked those parts of the transcript to be withheld. The pages proposed to be withheld are pages 3-49, 53-60, and 90-98. The non-relevant testimony concerned the KGB (matters unrelated to the Kennedy case) and, in addition, a separate discussion concerning a country in the Middle East. I have reviewed this testimony, I agree that it has no relevance to the JFK assassination, and I concur in the CIA's determination not to release it under the JFK Act.
