Dear Ms. Winner:

This letter follows up on our conversation last week in which you indicated that DIA's responding to specific requests of the Assassination Records Review Board ("Review Board") would obviate the need for submission by DIA of a Final Statement of Compliance.

We are writing to re-affirm that the DIA must submit a Final Statement of Compliance certifying that it has complied with the JFK Assassination Records Collection Act. DIA was previously notified of this requirement. *See* Dec. 10, 1996 Letter from David G. Marwell to Patrick M. Hughes and Feb. 6, 1997 Letter from Ronald G. Haron to Anne Winner.

Therefore, DIA must submit a Final Compliance Statement that details what it has done to locate and process records relating to the assassination of President Kennedy. The Final Compliance Statement should include, for example, what DIA has done to respond to specific Review Board requests for certain categories of documents. We are willing to discuss with you further the content and timing for submission of the Final Compliance Statement.
