Re: FBI's Final Declaration of Compliance under the
JFK Assassination Records Collection Act

Dear Carol:

In my May 11, 1998 letter to you, I requested that the FBI, in its Final Declaration of Compliance, account for any files that Director Hoover may have separately maintained regarding the assassination of President Kennedy (*see* footnote 2 of letter). In addition, please determine and explain in the FBI's Final Declaration, as best you can, the disposition of Associate Director Clyde Tolson's files from 1963-64. As we have previously noted, the FBI has a chron file for Mr. Tolson that covers January 1965 to April 1972, and we seek from FBI an accounting for the absence of pre-1965 Tolson files.

I apologize for not making this request explicit in my May 11 letter regarding FBI's Final Declaration. Please call me if you have any questions.
