to the Assassination Records Review Board

Dear Dr. Haynes:

To facilitate the work of the Assassination Records Review Board ("Review Board") in identifying records on President Kennedy's assassination, I am writing to authorize that certain papers I donated to the Library of Congress be made available for inspection by the Review Board.

Therefore, please allow the Review Board access to my files relating to the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence (container nos. 30-35) so that the Review Board may identify, under JFK Act, any materials relating to the Kennedy assassination. In addition, I authorize you to open in full, as an assassination record under the JFK Act, my file relating to the Kennedy assassination ("Kennedy, John F., assassination, 1975-78, n.d."). I defer to the Review Board and the Library of Congress as to the need to have any material reviewed by appropriate Government agencies prior to public release.

To the extent that the Review Board designates any other material as an assassination record, then this constitutes my authorization to have such materials opened in full by the Library of Congress.
