Subject:	Library of Congress Final Declaration of Compliance

Enclosed is the Final Declaration of Compliance submitted to us on January 30, 1998. For your review, I am enclosing my copy with the attachments, and I have highlighted items of interest (please return to me when done). I would like to discuss with you our response to the Library and any possible follow-up work.

The Library has identified three sets of restricted records that relate to the assassination of President Kennedy: (1) Vice-President Nelson Rockefeller's set of Rockefeller Commission records, estimated to be 15 linear feet in volume (access requires permission of CIA until 2002); (2) 2 folders of Daniel Moynihan on the assassination (access requires his permission); and (3) files of Howard Liebengold, an aide to Howard Baker, in connection with his work on the Church Committee, including one folder on the JFK assassination (access requires his permission). All other assassination-related material is fully open to the public.

We should discuss after you have had a chance to review the Delcaration.
