Thank you for submitting the Final Declaration of Compliance for the National Security Council ("NSC") (dated April 30, 1998), which sets forth NSC's final, sworn statement regarding its compliance with the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992 ("JFK Act").

Although a small number of documents remain in processing for release, we have reviewed NSC's Final Declaration of Compliance and have concluded that NSC's work under the JFK Act is substantially complete. Furthermore, we do not anticipate interviewing you (as the NSC compliance official) regarding NSC's searches. The Review Board might request that NSC conduct further record searches if we acquire information suggesting that NSC might have additional records relating to the assassination of President Kennedy. Should NSC locate any additional records relating to the assassination, please transmit those records to the Chief of the JFK Collection at College Park, Maryland.

Finally, NSC should continue to review, under the JFK Act, its equities in any assassination records that may be referred to it by other agencies.

Please contact me if you have any further questions, and thank you again for your

cooperation in meeting the requirements of the Review Board's compliance program
under the JFK Act.
