Dear Ms. Allen:

Thank you for submitting your Final Declaration of Compliance for the United States Postal Service ("Postal Service") (dated July 7, 1997), which sets forth the Postal Service's final, sworn statement regarding its compliance with the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992 ("JFK Act").

We have reviewed the Postal Service's Final Declaration of Compliance and have concluded that the Postal Service's work under the JFK Act is complete. Furthermore, we do not anticipate conducting a compliance deposition. The Review Board might request that the Postal Service conduct additional record searches if we acquire information suggesting that the Postal Service might have additional records relating to the assassination of President Kennedy. Should the Postal Service locate any additional records relating to the assassination, please transmit those records to the Chief of the JFK Assassination Records Collection ("JFK Collection") at the National Archives and Records Administration ("NARA").

We understand that the Postal Service has identified, as an assassination record, an investigative file that contained "agency letters, investigative memoranda, and inspectors' reports regarding the assistance that the [Postal] Inspection Service provided to the FBI during the investigation" of the Kennedy assassination and that this file has been transmitted to the JFK Collection. See Postal Service Decl. of Compl. at 1, 6. No other assassination-related records have been located by the

Postal Service.

Please contact me if you have any further questions, and thank you again for your cooperation in meeting the requirements of the Review Board's Compliance Program under the JFK Act.
