Dear Mr. Dougherty:

This will confirm our recent conversation in which you stated that the Department of Treasury will submit to the Review Board, by February 20, 1998, its Final Declaration of Compliance under the JFK Act. The Final Declaration must be executed under penalty of perjury pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746.

We presume that, by the end of February, the Department of Treasury will forward all its assassination records to the JFK Assassination Records Collection at the National Archives and Records Administration at College Park, Maryland. We also presume that the Department of Treasury is not seeking to postpone the release of any additional material under the JFK Act. If this is inaccurate, please let me know.
