Re: White House Communications Agency Records and the
JFK Assassination Records Collection Act, 44 U.S.C. § 2107

Dear Lt. Col. Raths:

Following up on my November 25, 1997 letter to you, I am writing to inquire as to the status of certain additional work that was to be completed by the White House Communications Agency ("WHCA") under the JFK Act.

The WHCA was to: (1) transmit its assassination records to Steve Tilley, Chief for the JFK Assassination Records Collection at the National Archives and Records Administration ("NARA") in College Park, Maryland; (2) provide certain background information regarding the WHCA organization in 1963-64; and (3) re-execute, under penalty of perjury, WHCA's Final Declaration of Compliance under the JFK Act. *See* Nov. 25, 1997 R. Haron Letter to G. Raths. We remain concerned that WHCA has, to date, been unable to provide any specific accounting with regard to the existence, identity or disposition of any of its records from the 1963-64 period.

We request that the WHCA complete its outstanding obligations no later than March 2, 1998. If you believe this cannot be reasonably accomplished by March 2, please let us know.
