

ASSASSINATION RECORDS REVIEW BOARD  
MINUTES  
JUNE 4, 1998 OPEN BOARD MEETING  
WASHINGTON, D. C.

The meeting was called to order by Chair John Tunheim at 1:40 p.m.

Participants in the meeting were Board Members Henry F. Graff, William L. Joyce, Anna K. Nelson, and John R. Tunheim; Steven D. Tilley, Chief, JFK Collection at National Archives and Records Administration; and Assassination Records Review Board Executive Director, T. Jeremy Gunn.

Indigo Films videotaped the meeting for a documentary on the work of the Board and the records released.

A motion was made by Dr. Joyce to accept the minutes of the May 12, 1998 Open Meeting. The motion was seconded by Dr. Graff and passed unanimously.

The purpose of the meeting was to continue discussion of what should go into the Final Report of the Assassination Records Review Board, especially the chapter to be written by the Members of the Board, which would cover what has been learned from this type of operation and recommendations for such future operations and the declassification of government records.

Judge Tunheim first asked Mr. Tilley to comment on the current status of the Collection.

The Board discussed the Final Report.

The public was invited to submit comments by July 1, 1998.

There being no further business to come before the Board in an open meeting, Dr. Graff's motion to adjourn was seconded by Dr. Joyce, and carried by a 4-0 vote. The meeting adjourned at 2:50 p.m.
