Pursuant to your February 6 conversation with Joe Freeman of my staff, I have enclosed copies of seven (7) records from the HSCA collection that should have been referred to your agency by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) in 1993.

As part of its responsibilities under the JFK Act, the Review Board is now reviewing records compiled by the HSCA to determine to what extent they may be made available to the public. Our Board will be making determinations concerning the release of the enclosed documents at its meeting of February 29, 1996. If NASA wishes to object to the release of any of these documents, or parts thereof, the agency should do so, with specificity, by February 22, 1996. Any objections to the release of specific documents should reference the NARA Record Number shown at the top of the Record Information Form attached to each document. Our Board will consider any evidence NASA wishes to submit in support of such objections.
