Re: Historical Records Related to Operation Big Lift, 1963

Dear General Mountcastle:

With the help of your staff, I recently discovered a document filed at the Center of Military History which meets the definition of assassination-related material as defined by the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992, 44 U.S.C. § 2107 (Supp. V 1994). The document is the USAREUR annual historical report for 1963. Though this document carries an overall classification of Top Secret, the assassination-relevant material is entirely in Chapter 2, "Exercise Big Lift," and is classified no higher than Secret-NOFORN.

The relevance of this material comes from the fact that a few researchers, including Hollywood director Oliver Stone in his film *JFK*, have alleged a connection between Operation Big Lift and contingency plans for a military coup timed to coincide with the assassination of the president. (For your information, I have attached an extract from the book *JFK: The Documented Screenplay* that specifically includes this allegation and its purported "documentation.")

In accordance with the JFK Records Collection Act, I therefore request that the relevant portion of the document cited above be copied and provided to me so that I can initiate actions to have it declassified and included in the JFK Assassination Collection at the National Archives.
