Thank you for agreeing to Participate in the Conference on Asian-Pacific American Leadership's (CAPAL) forum on Coalition Building and South-Asian Participation. We believe this is a very important but not often discussed topic. Our goal for the evening is to begin a dialogue between the South-Asian and greater Asian-Pacific American (APA) communities so to foster better communication and collaboration, particularly relating to public policy. We very much look forward to hearing your comments and ideas.

As you can see from the enclosed flyer, the event will take place on Wednesday, May 14, 1997 from 6:30pm to 8:30pm in 2325 Rayburn House Office Building. Bhargava, V.P. of Risk Management Division, Fleet Bank and the format is as follows: 6:30pm to 6:50pm - reception. 6:50pm to 6:55pm - welcome by Angelo Chang, Chair of CAPAL. Sydney Reddy introduction of program and moderator. 6:55pm to 7:05pm - moderator introduces panel. 7:05pm to 7:50pm - panel. each speaker takes no more than 8-10 minutes to speak. moderator summarizes main points made by each speaker. moderator describes goal of break-out groups. 7:50pm to 8:15pm - break-out groups. facilitators lead discussion of possible steps to foster better relations. 8:15pm to 8:30pm - break-out groups report out and closing.
